

Great RGS Bake Off and Recipe Book

Over the next eighteen months we are hoping to put together a Ripon Grammar School recipe book to raise funds for the Jenny Unwin Appeal and the Parents' Association. As well as favourite tried and tested recipes from students, staff, parents and the community, it will contain contributions from subject departments in school. For example, the Geography department may look at local farming and food supply; PE might consider healthy eating and sport.



We will shortly be asking for your recipes, so please look out for announcements on this.

To launch our scheme we are holding a Great RGS Bake Off competition for students and parents. There will be an overall winner, but within school students will also gain House points for all entries and extra points for House winners.

The Great RGS Bake Off will take place on Wednesday 1st July 2015 (Sports Day). All entries should be in school to room S4 by 9.00a.m. that day. Judging will take place at lunch time and then all the cakes will be sliced and sold the following day for £1 per slice. The proceeds from the cake sale will be shared between the Jenny Unwin Appeal and funds for producing the recipe book.

The winning baker will receive the Great RGS Bake Off trophy plate and vouchers for Lakeland Plastics and **the winning cake** will feature prominently in the forthcoming RGS Recipe Book.

Here are the entry details:

- *Bake a decorated cake or cakes with a **BOOK** theme*
- *You can include any edible filling*
- *You can include any edible decorations*

N.B. All ingredients must be nut-free, including almond essence
