ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED WITH WOVEN NAME TAPES

Blazer	Regulation with school buttons	
Skirt	Ripon Grammar School navy blue regulation A line skirt which has the school crest embroidered above the hem. The skirt must be worn on or below the knee.	
Trousers	Mid-grey, standard width bottoms without turn-ups. Black or charcoal grey trousers ARE NOT ALLOWED . Skinny, tight fitting or drainpipe trousers and leggings are not permitted. A plain black belt may be worn with the trousers.	
Tie	Regulation school tie to be worn by students. Alternatively, the sixth form may wear a "Sixth form tie" and Boarders may wear a "Boarding tie". "Special ties" awarded by the school for excellence in sport/music etc. may be worn by the recipient of the award.	
White shirts	Long sleeves (during the summer term a short-sleeved shirt may be worn with tie).	
Tights	Opaque black tights to be worn with the skirt.	
Socks	Mid-grey or black to be worn with trousers.	
Shoes	Plain black, <u>flat or with low, stout heel</u> . Boots, trainers, suede, trainer type shoes or shoes with high/stiletto/kitten heels are not acceptable. Please avoid deeply ridged soles or heels which can hold dirt and mark floors.	

Other items of uniform:

Coat	A warm and weather-proof coat may be worn on the journey to and from school.	
DT/Art Apron	Compulsory years 7-9. Required if studying Art /DT at GCSE & A Level.	
School bag	Must support the weight of books.	
School Jumper (optional)	Dark navy-blue, long-sleeved with the school crest - available from official uniform stockists.	
Scarf (optional)	RGS school colours – available from official uniform stockists.	
Vest (optional)	Must be plain white. No tee shirts with logos.

Available from The Ripon Uniform Shop and Smart Start. If students choose to wear the summer dress it must be worn with a school blazer and flesh coloured tights.

The school dress **MUST** be worn at knee length/below the knee.

The dress may be worn with an adjustable navy blue belt. The belt is an optional item of uniform and can be purchased from the school suppliers.

A school blazer MUST be worn with the dress; no school jumpers or cardigans are allowed.

Short sleeved shirt

In summer, students may opt to wear a short-sleeved shirt with their tie and blazer. In instances of extreme heat, the school will direct students to 'shirt sleeve order' (no blazer) and if necessary, removal of ties.
