What is Hate Crime?

Hate Crime is any crime committed against someone where the motivation has been hostility, prejudice or hatred towards that person because of their:

- -Disability including physical, hearing and visual impairments, mental ill health and learning disabilities
- -Race nationality, ethnicity, skin colour and heritage
- -Faith includes religion, belief, including non-religious belief
- -Sexual orientation people who identify as lesbian, gay, bi-sexual or heterosexual
- -Gender Identity people who identify as 'trans', including transgender or transexual people.

Incidents may involve:

-Physical assault -Verbal abuse -Damage to property -Hate mail -Bullying -Insults

-Harassment -Offensive graffiti

In school our local police school liaison officer has been delivering assemblies to all year groups about Hate Crime. All students are encouraged to report any incidents of hate to staff.

Outside of school there are several ways you can report a hate crime, whether you have been a victim, a witness, or you are reporting on behalf of someone else:

- -If it's an emergency dial 999
- -Non-emergencies dial 101
- -Visit your local police enquiry office.

Stop Hate UK (https://www.stophateuk.org/) operates a 24hr free phone service for victims and witnesses. Stop Hate UK is totally independent of the police and will not pass on callers details without explicit consent. If a caller wishes however, Stop Hate UK will report the incident to the police on their behalf.
