Business

This has been established as a popular and highly successful subject within the Sixth Form curriculum. The role would entail teaching A-Level Business with approximately 30 students opting to study this course next year.

Currently the Economics and Business department consists of a Head of department (Mr Demir) and Miss Anderson, who between them share the teaching of Economics and Business.

The department currently offers A-level Business (AQA, 7132) and A-Level Economics (AQA, 7136). All students are issued with up-to-date textbooks approved by AQA. Lessons are typically teacher-led using a worksheet and PowerPoint. These teaching resources are available if required.

Students are encouraged to work beyond the curriculum and engage with current affairs. They are expected to develop a good general knowledge focused on how business concepts

Students have the opportunity to participate in the Young Enterprise competition. There is a student-led Economics Society which meets to debate topical issues. The department achieves very good results in public examinations.

In 2022/23 the students achieved:

A-Level Business: 94.4 %, A*-C and 77.8 %, A*-B

A-Level Economics: 100%, A*-C and 93.3%, A*-A
